To the CITY CLERK of Somerville.

Statements having been filed with the City Clerk, November 9, 1916 at 9:00 o'clock P. M., and transmitted by him to this board, signed and sworn to by James J. Shay, George F. Pratt, Oscar F. Godding, Arthur H. Richardson, Fred E. Durgin, Joseph J. Pinhas and Eugene A. P. Burnett, qualified voters of wards one, two, three, four, five, six and seven, and signed by ten other qualified voters of each of said wards, to the effect that the said qualified voters of said wards have reason to believe and do believe that the records or copies of records made by the election officers of the several precincts, namely, precincts one, two, three and four in said ward one, precincts one, two and three in said ward two, precincts one and two in said ward three, precincts one and two in said ward four, precincts one, two and three in said ward five, precincts one, two and three in said ward six, precincts one, two, three and four in said ward seven, of the election held therein November 7, 1916, are erroneous in that the ballots cast at said election, in each and all of said precincts for CONGRESSMAN, NINTH DISTRICT were not by the election officers of said precincts correctly counted or computed, or correctly entered in the records and returns of said election, and the number of ballots cast in said precincts for the several candidates for CONGRESSMAN, NINTH DISTRICT was not correctly stated in the records or copies of records or returns made by the election officers of the several precincts aforesaid, and that the said qualified voters believe a recount of the ballots cast in said precincts will affect the election of the following named candidates who were voted for at said election, namely, - Alvin T. Fuller and Ernest E. Roberts; and the City Clerk having delivered to this board the boxes containing the ballots cast in all of said precincts in said wards at said election, and this board having given notice in writing to the several candidates interested in and liable to be affected thereby, that it would meet at the City Hall, this Wednesday, November 16, 1916 at 9 o'clock in the forenoon for the purpose of recounting said ballots and determining said questions raised, and this board having met at the said time and place, and opened the boxes containing said ballots, and having recounted the votes cast on said ballots for candidates for CONGRESSMAN, NINTH DISTRICT, and having returned said ballots to said boxes and sealed said boxes and certified thereon as required by law, the candidates interested as aforesaid having been present or represented by agents appointed by them in writing at said account as follows, namely:-

Alvin T. Fuller, represented by Robert B. Parker and Maurice Flynn.

Ernest E. Roberts, present in person, accompanied with his counsel,
