To the City Clerk of Somerville.

Statements having been filed with the City Clerk, December 17, 1915 at 4.48 o'clock P.M., and transmitted by him to this board, signed and sworn to by Francis X. McCarty and Henry T. Noonan, qualified voters of ward one, and signed also by ten other qualified voters of said ward, to the effect that the said qualified voters of said ward have reason to believe and do believe that the records or copies of records made by the election officers of the several precincts, namely, precincts one, two, three, and four in said ward, of the election held therein December 14, 1915 are erroneous in that the ballots cast at said election, in each and all of said precincts, for WARD ALDERMEN AND SCHOOL COMMITTEE were not by the election officers of said precincts correctly counted or computed, or correctly entered in the records and returns of said election, and the number of ballots cast in said precincts for the several candidates for WARD ALDERMEN AND SCHOOL COMMITTEE was not correctly stated in the records or copies of records or returns made by the election officers of the several precincts aforesaid, and that the said qualified voters believe a recount of the ballots cast in said precincts will affect the election of the following named candidates who were voted for at said election, namely,- William J. Casey, George N. Coyle, Wallace E. Loveless, John A. Mack, George L. Doherty, and James J. Rudd; and the City Clerk having delivered to this board the boxes containing the ballots cast in all of said precincts in said ward at said election, and this board having given notice in writing to the several candidates interested in and liable to be affected thereby, that it would meet at the City Hall, this Tuesday, December 21, 1915 at 7.30 o'clock in the afternoon for the purpose of recounting said ballots and determining said questions raised, and this board having met at the said time and place, and opened the boxes containing said ballots, and having recounted the votes cast on said ballots for candidates for WARD ALDERMEN AND MEMBERS OF SCHOOL COMMITTEE, and having returned said ballots to said boxes and resealed said boxes and certified thereon as required by law, the candidates interested as aforesaid having been present or represented by agents appointed by them in writing at said recount as follows, namely:-

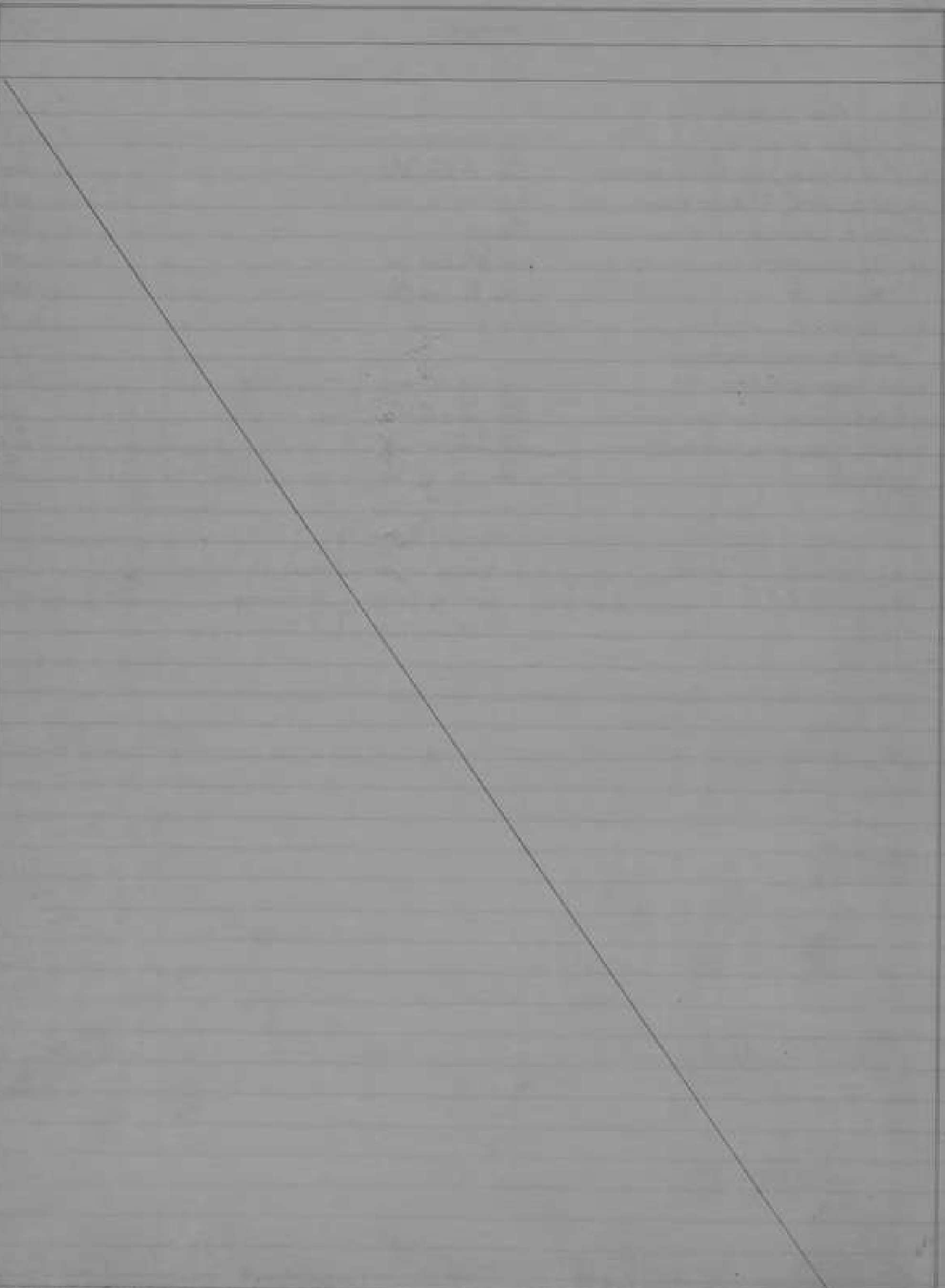

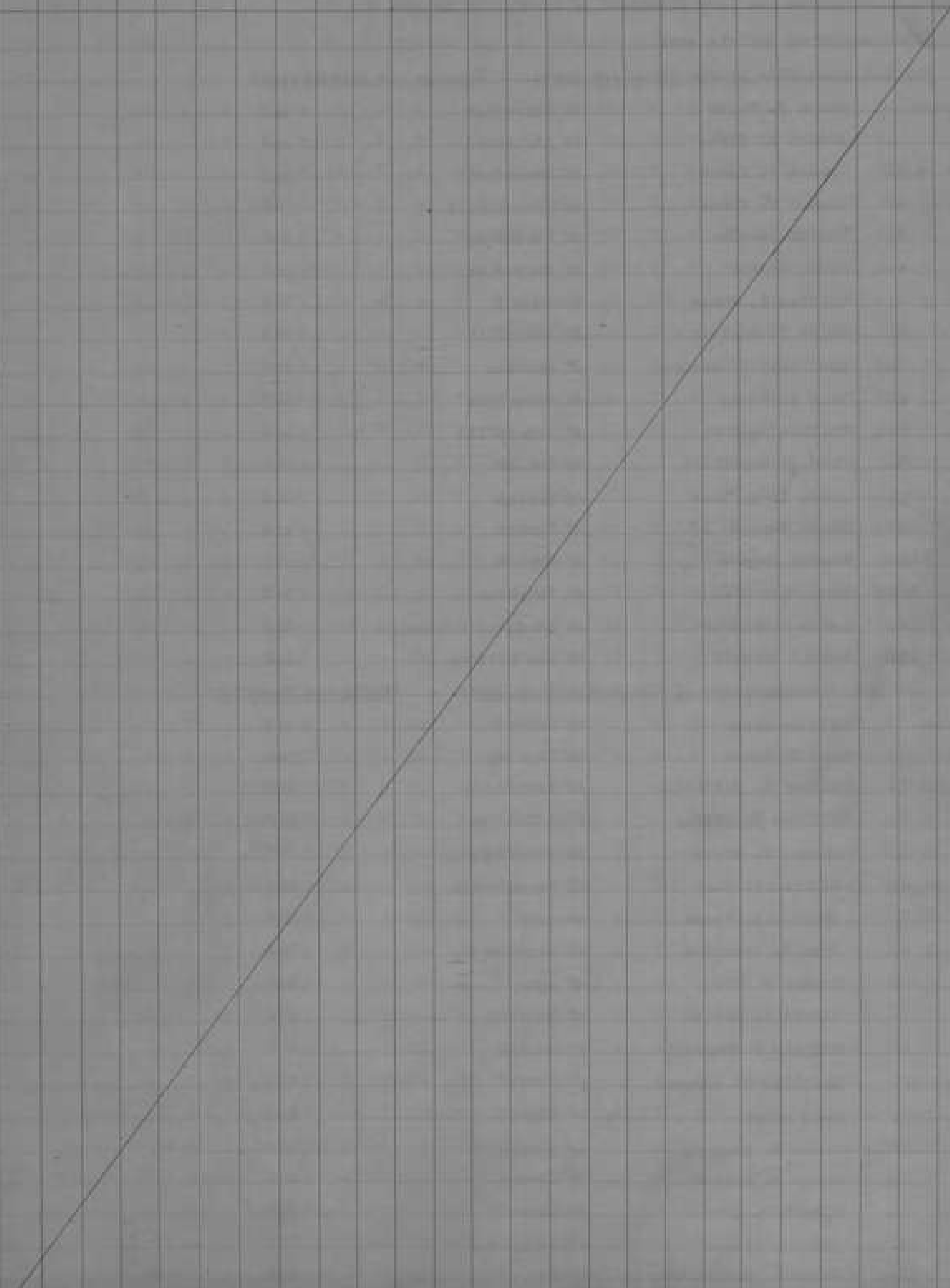

Roberts; and the City Clerk having delivered to this board the boxes containing the ballots cast in all of said precincts in said wards at said election, and this board having given notice in writing to the several candidates interested in and liable to be affected thereby, that it would meet at the City Hall, this Wednesday, November 15, 1916 at 9 o'clock in the forenoon for the purpose of recounting said ballots and determining said questions raised, and this board having met at the said time and place, and opened the boxes containing said ballots, and having recounted the votes cast on said ballots for candidates for CONGRESSMAN, NINTH DISTRICT, and having returned said ballots to said boxes and resealed said boxes and certified thereon as required by law, the candidates interested as aforesaid having been present or represented by agents appointed by them in writing at said recount as follows, namely:-
